HISTORIC MAASTRICHT

### DAY 1 – AMSTERDAM

Welcome to Amsterdam, capital of the Netherlands and affectionately known as “Damsko”. Embark the luxurious Riverside Debussy and relax as you settle in. Tonight, meet fellow cruise-mates during your first gourmet dinner on board.

### DAY 2 – ARNHEM / NIJMEGEN

Begin your day in Arnhem, which WWII enthusiasts will know as home of the infamous “Bridge Too Far”, as well as the Airborne Museum and Eusebius Church. You can see them all during one of our enriching RIVERSIDE CHOICE excursions. If colorful blooms are more your thing, don’t miss our outing to Keukenhof Gardens, where millions of dazzling tulips put on quite a show each spring! Later on board, join your Beer Sommelier for a UNIQUELY RIVERSIDE onboard presentation about the Netherlands’ long and beer-brewing tradition – tastings included! Finally, arrive in Nijmegen, the oldest city in the country, dating back to Roman times. Enjoy a guided walk through the Old Town, featuring the 16-sided Sint Nicolaas Chapel; De Waagh (weigh house), built in 1612 and still sporting a huge set of scales inside; the Grote Markt; City Hall; and more.

### DAY 3 – MAASTRICHT

After-lunch arrival in Maastricht, birthplace of the euro! Enjoy a guided walk to see some of the 1,600-plus national heritage buildings. If you prefer, go subterranean to explore the city’s

800-year-old caves, which served as an underground battleground against French troops in the 18th century; a hiding place (for both people and priceless works of art) from the Nazis during WWII; and more. Another option is our Dutch Wine Experience to taste a selection of area wines.
