MILTENBERG

Other ports include the wine tavern-lined Drosselgasse in Rüdesheim, where the area's famous Rieslings are served; the hilltop fortress at Würzburg; and Bamberg, where residents built their Town Hall right in the middle of the river in 1386 when the bishop refused to grant land for it. Your cruise concludes in Nuremberg, one of Germany's most multi-faceted cities!

## DAY 3 – DÜSSELDORF

Welcome to Düsseldorf, an international business and financial center with more than 700 years of history. If you're feeling active, see the Old Town, Königsallee shopping district, and Media Harbor from the seat of an electric bicycle. Other possibilities include a fun foodie walk, an art safari, and an Altbier discovery to try the city's famous copper-colored brew for yourself!

## DAY 4 – RHINE GORGE SCENIC CRUISING / RÜDESHEIM

A leisurely start to the day, but you won't want to spend it sleeping as your ship passes through some of Europe's most spectacular scenery. Cruise through the dramatic Rhine Gorge, where for more than a millennium, the riverbanks have been graced by more than three-dozen stunning hilltop castles. Also see the mythical Rock of the Loreley and hear its haunting legend. Later, disembark in the quaint wine village of Rüdesheim for the activity that appeals most to you! Maybe hop aboard the Winzerexpress train to see the sights and visit Siegfried's Mechanical Music Museum; soar over the area by cable car, followed by an authentic Rüdesheimer Coffee; or stroll through the vineyards at the Breuer Winery, followed by a tasting of Middle Rhine wines.

## DAY 5 – MILTENBERG

Awaken this morning on an entirely different river! As you slept, the ship entered the Main for afternoon arrival in the Bavarian town of Miltenberg. Excursion options feature a fascinating Jewish heritage tour that visits a 13th-century synagogue. Also available: a nature hike up a 2,000-year-old Roman path and food tastings at the city's 17th-century butcher shop, or an encounter with Miltenberg's fantastic medieval architecture and superb Bavarian cuisine.

## DAY 6 – WÜRZBURG

Head out today to discover the wonders of Würzburg. Stroll through the resplendent Old Town and wander through the Residenz, one of Europe's most magnificent palaces, or get a real taste of Würzburg's culture on a guided walk featuring the cathedral, the Old Town Bridge – and the best sausages in the city! An outing is also available along the famed Romantic Road to the must-see medieval city of Rothenburg.

## DAY 7 – BAMBERG

One of Germany's unrivaled masterpieces awaits in the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Bamberg. Dating back to the 9th century, the city extends over seven church-capped hills, leading to its nickname – Franconian Rome. Join a guided walk that visits the four-towered cathedral founded in 1004 AD, the old fishermen's huts lining the canals of Little Venice, and the unusual Old Town Hall, built right in the middle of the river in 1386! Or, how about a tour focusing on the Rauchbier (smoked beer) the city has been brewing for almost 900 years?
