DAY 1 – BASEL

DAY 2 – STRASBOURG

Arrive this morning in Strasbourg, one of France's most popular cities. Plenty of RIVERSIDE CHOICE excursions are on offer throughout the day: a guided tour of Old Town Strasbourg and its beautiful cathedral; a panoramic tour and canal cruise; or wine tasting in the medieval village of Obernai. DAY 3 – MANNHEIM

Stop today in Mannheim, where the Rhine and Neckar Rivers meet. Consider a guided walk and visit to the massive Baroque palace (second only to Versailles in size). Or, visit the lovely Schwetzingen Palace Gardens; take an entertaining stroll with "Bertha Benz" to learn about the many inventions created here; or soar over the region during a helicopter flightseeing tour for a bird's-eye view of Mannheim and neighboring Heidelberg.

DAY 4 – RÜDESHEIM / RHINE GORGE SCENIC CRUISING / KOBLENZ

Today you've arrived in the heart of the Middle Rhine, one of the river's prettiest sections. Disembark in the popular wine village of Rüdesheim and jump right into its welcoming atmosphere. For a relaxed approach to sightseeing, hop aboard the Winzerexpress train, then visit Siegfried's Mechanical Music Museum; soar over the area by cable car; or satisfy your active side during a hilltop hike. Then, reboard your ship for a true highlight as you cruise through the stunning Rhine Gorge, home to more than three dozen castles lining both sides of the river. Afternoon arrival in Koblenz, where the Rhine and Moselle Rivers meet. Join a local expert to see the best of the Old Town and the iconic "German Corner" monument, poised dramatically on a river peninsula. Alternatively, visit Marksburg, the only castle in the Rhine Gorge that has never been destroyed; or ride a cable car up to 16th-century Ehrenbreitstein Fortress.

DAY 5 – COLOGNE

After an easy start to the morning, arrive in monumental Cologne, whose skyline is shaped by a

dozen historical churches. Visit its most famous during an inside tour through the Gothic, twin-spired cathedral, home to the Shrine of the Three Magi. You could also join a palate-pleasing excursion to the Chocolate Museum, a captivating Jewish heritage tour, or pedal your way past the sights during a fun e-bike adventure.

DAY 6 – ROTTERDAM

Enjoy the morning your way – linger a little longer at breakfast, exercise in the Fitness Center, or just relax and admire the beautiful scenery. After lunch, your ship pulls into Rotterdam, the bustling Gateway to the World! Its rich history began in 1270, when a dam was built on the Rotte River. Today, Rotterdam is the EU's 10th-largest metropolitan area and Europe's largest seaport. With RIVERSIDE CHOICE, investigate the city's modern architecture, including its unusual Cube Houses; visit a traditional Dutch cheese farm; or head to Kinderdijk to admire real Dutch windmills.

DAY 7 – AMSTERDAM

Your day starts with breakfast and a glorious entrance into Amsterdam, the awe-inspiring Venice of the North. How about an unforgettable trip to Keukenhof for a quintessential Dutch tulip experience? DAY 3 – COLOGNE / BONN

Magnificent Cologne steps center stage today. You'll be struck first by its skyline, which is shaped by a dozen Romanesque churches, including its famous twin-spired cathedral. Cologne is also known for its "Eau de Cologne" perfume, which has been produced in the city since 1709. See the highlights, taste the chocolate – there's

no shortage of things to see and do! Later, cruise on to Bonn, Germany's former capital and birthplace of composer Ludwig van Beethoven. Join us for a tour to see the delightful Wilhelminian-style architecture, Museum Mile, and more.

DAY 4 – RHINE GORGE SCENIC CRUISING / RÜDESHEIM

Today you've entered the heart of the Middle Rhine, one of the river's prettiest sections. As a vital trade route since prehistoric times, this region grew in power and wealth, with more than three-dozen hilltop castles constructed during the Middle Ages. Combined with the terraced vineyards, fairytale villages, and enduring Loreley legend, you've got a photographer's dream on

both sides of the river. After lunch on board, disembark in popular Rudesheim, where you can join a tasting of the area's famous Rieslings, or soar over the landscape by cable car, followed by an authentic Rudesheimer Coffee. This evening, don't miss our RIVERSIDE SIGNATURE visit to the must-see collection of musical curiosities at Siegfried's Mechanical Music Museum. Afterward, enjoy an old-time silent movie experience, complete with champagne and accompanying music on a restored historical organ.

DAY 5 – MANNHEIM / SPEYER

Our spotlight shines first today on Mannheim, where the Rhine and Neckar Rivers meet. During a RIVERSIDE CHOICE guided walk, hear about the city's unusual street layout and ties to many inventions throughout history. Then, visit the massive Baroque palace (second only to Versailles in size). Other options are an outing to the ornamental Schwetzingen Palace Gardens, or a jaunt to Heidelberg to see its legendary castle ruin – including a wine vat so enormous, it has a dance floor on top of it! After lunch, turn your attention to 2,000-year-old Speyer, one of Germany's oldest cities. Consider an enriching Jewish heritage tour, or time at the fascinating Technology Museum.

DAY 6 – STRASBOURG

A big “bonjour” as you arrive in the unforgettable French city of Strasbourg, whose historic city center, the Grande Île (Grand Island), is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Experience the highlights with RIVERSIDE CHOICE, like an inside visit of the sandstone Gothic cathedral with its ancient astronomical clock. A cruise along the romantic canals is also available, as well as a guided e-bike ride, or a tour to medieval Obernai for wine tasting.

DAY 7 – BREISACH

In Breisach, you'll discover the captivating gateway between the French Alsace region and Germany's legendary Black Forest. Morning excursion choices are a wine cellar tasting experience, or a hike through Ravenna Gorge. After lunch, return for an enjoyable guided e-bike tour, or an outing to Freiburg, Germany's southernmost town.
