AMSTERDAM TO TRIER – 6 DAYS / 5 NIGHTS



DEUTSCHES ECK (GERMAN CORNER), KOBLENZ

Better give your camera phone a rest now, because this brilliant cruise is bound to give it a nonstop workout! Embark in Amsterdam, the Venice of the North with its charming canals. Then, cruise along the Lower Rhine and enter Germany for stops in Düsseldorf with its awe-inspiring rococo castle; regal Cologne, whose iconic cathedral is recognized worldwide; and Remagen, site of a bloody 18-day bridge battle during WWII that experts say shortened the war in Europe. At Koblenz, the Rhine meets up with the Moselle, a peaceful waterway known for its lush vineyards and tasty wines. Visit Bernkastel, where humans have lived since at least 3000 BC; and Roman Trier, Germany's oldest city!

DAY 1 – AMSTERDAM

DAY 2 – AMSTERDAM

Rise and shine! Begin your day with breakfast before stepping off the ship to explore. With your RIVERSIDE CHOICE selection of excursions, you can enjoy a canal cruise to see the merchant homes from the Dutch Golden Age, then spend time with the Dutch masters at the incredible Rijksmuseum. Also available: a unique virtual reality experience that follows in the footsteps of Anne Frank; a visit to the Royal Palace of Amsterdam and chance to sample traditional Dutch apple pie at the palace café; or time at the intriguing Street Art & Graffiti Museum.

DAY 3 – COLOGNE

Enjoy a relaxing morning of scenic cruising. After lunch, disembark in monumental Cologne, whose skyline is shaped by 12 historical churches! The

city's eternal legacy, though, stems from one in particular – its twin-spired cathedral. With RIVERSIDE CHOICE, stroll through the Old Town and visit the landmark cathedral. Alternatively, treat your tastebuds at the Cologne Chocolate Museum or on a captivating Kölsch Beer Discovery; or take a virtual reality “timeride” to experience what Cologne was like in the distant past. Your ship remains in port until late.

DAY 4 – KOBLENZ / RHINE GORGE WITH LORELEI ROCK

Morning arrival in ancient Koblenz at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle Rivers. Led by a local expert, see the best of the Old Town and the iconic “German Corner” monument. Then, re-board your ship and grab your camera, because words won't do justice to the wonders of the Rhine Gorge. As a vital trade route since prehistoric times, this region grew in power and wealth and saw the construction of more than three dozen hilltop castles and fortresses during the Middle Ages. Combined with the steep terraced vineyards, tiny fairytale-style villages, and enduring legends like the Rock of the Lorelei, you've got a river landscape like no other. To add to the experience, enjoy a UNIQUELY RIVERSIDE Rüdeshheimer Coffee-making demonstration, followed by a tasting of the unforgettable local specialty!

DAY 5 – BERNKASTEL

A wonderful morning for a leisurely breakfast, time to admire the striking beauty of the Moselle Valley, or to take advantage of your ship's many amenities. How about a massage or spa treatment, or a dip in the pool? After lunch, stop in splendid Bernkastel. The medieval marketplace here is particularly eye-catching with its gabled, split-timber architecture and captivating Spitzhäuschen (Pointed House) from 1416. Your RIVERSIDE CHOICE includes a guided walk through the historical district, followed by tasting at a local winery; a hike up to the ruins of mighty Landshut Castle; or a ride through the beautiful environs of the middle Moselle in a classic VW Bulli, with a tasting of locally produced wines!

DAY 6 – TRIER

After breakfast, disembark the Riverside Debussy and enjoy complimentary transfers to the airport, train station, or central hotel.
