AMSTERDAM TO TRIER – 6 DAYS / 5 NIGHTS



MOSELLE

Better give your camera a rest now, because this brilliant cruise is bound to give it a nonstop workout! Embark in Amsterdam, the Netherlands' capital and show-stopping Venice of the North with its charming canals. Then, cruise along the Lower Rhine and enter Germany for a stop in regal Cologne, whose iconic twin-steeped cathedral is recognized worldwide. At Koblenz, the Rhine meets up with the Moselle, a peaceful waterway known for its lush vineyards and tasty wines. Visit quaint and colorful Bernkastel, and Roman Trier, Germany's oldest city. A true trip highlight is passage through the mesmerizing Rhine Gorge, where foreboding castles, lush hillside vineyards, and inviting wine villages create a memorable scene.

As you cruise through the stunning beauty of the Moselle Valley, learn the secrets behind the area's acclaimed wines. Join an expert oenologist for an onboard talk that introduces you to the distinct characteristics of the soil and steep nature of the vineyards. Then, taste several varieties yourself!

DAY 1 – AMSTERDAM

Welcome to Amsterdam, capital of the Netherlands and “Venice of the North”, where more than 62 miles (100 km) of canals zigzag through the city. Embark the luxurious Riverside Debussy and relax as you settle in. Tonight, meet fellow shipmates during your first gourmet dinner on board. Your ship remains in port overnight, so feel free to check out Amsterdam’s exciting nightlife!

DAY 2 – AMSTERDAM

Begin the day with breakfast your way before stepping off the ship to explore. How about a made-to-order omelette, fresh fruit, and toasted artisan bread with homemade jam or honey, right off the comb? Afterward, a great selection of RIVERSIDE CHOICE excursions awaits. You could cruise along the romantic canals, or join a virtual reality tour that follows in the footsteps of Anne Frank. See our website for a complete list of available options. Later, return to the ship for a relaxing afternoon of lunch and scenic cruising.

DAY 3 – COLOGNE

A leisurely morning is followed by after-lunch arrival in monumental Cologne, whose skyline is shaped by a dozen historical churches. Make the most of your time here with a tour through the Old Town and visit to the landmark twin-spired cathedral; a palate-pleasing chocolate or Kölsch Beer discovery; or a fun e-bike tour to see the sights.

DAY 4 – KOBLENZ / RHINE GORGE SCENIC CRUISING

Stop this morning in ancient Koblenz, where the Rhine and Moselle Rivers meet. Join a local ex-

pert to see the best of the Old Town and the iconic “German Corner” monument, poised dramatically out onto the river. Alternatively, visit Marksburg, the only castle in the Rhine Gorge that has never been destroyed, or ride a cable car up to 16th-century Ehrenbreitstein Fortress. Afterward, reboard your ship and grab your camera, because words won’t do justice to the wonders of the Rhine Gorge. As a vital trade route since prehistoric times, this region grew in power and wealth, with more than three-dozen hilltop castles and fortresses constructed during the Middle Ages. Combined with the steep terraced vineyards, fairytale villages, and enduring Loreley legend, you’ve got a riverscape like no other.

DAY 5 – BERNKASTEL

Awaken this morning in the heart of the ancient Moselle River Valley. Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and time to admire the area’s striking beauty, then join us for a UNIQUELY RIVERSIDE on-board presentation about Moselle Valley wines. Learn about the unique growing conditions here and enjoy a tasting to see what makes the wines so popular. After lunch, arrive in splendid Bernkastel. The medieval marketplace here is particularly eye-catching with its gabled, split-timber architecture and mesmerizing Spitzhäuschen (Pointed House) from 1416. Whether you participate in a guided walk through the Old Town or see the sights by electric bicycle, Bernkastel will leave a lasting impression!

DAY 6 – TRIER
