DAY 1 - BUDAPEST

DAY 4 – DÜRNSTEIN / MELK

DAY 5 – PASSAU

Early risers might enjoy a day trip to Mozart's exquisite Salzburg or to the medieval walled city of Český Krumlov in the Czech Republic. For a more leisurely start to the day, enjoy scenic cruising and afternoon arrival in Passau, where

the Inn, IIz, and Danube converge. Awaiting your discovery are a RIVERSIDE CHOICE orientation of the medieval city center; a tour and tasting of one of the city's major products – beer; or a hands-on art workshop.

DAY 6 - REGENSBURG

Mid-morning port of call in Regensburg, where many cultures built the city over 2,000 years. RIVERSIDE CHOICE excursions are a walk through the Old Town and sample of sausage at the world's oldest continuously operating restaurant, or a behind-the-scenes look at the ancient craft of hat making. You can also enjoy a boat ride to Weltenburg Abbey, where monks began brewing beer in 1050 AD, or spend time exploring on your own.

DAY 7 – NUREMBERG

Bewitchingly beautiful yet historically damaged, few cities have suffered the split personality that Nuremberg has. Today, you'll get the backstory and with RIVERSIDE CHOICE, you have options. Alternatively, learn how Nuremberg protected its most important art treasures during WWII in underground rock vaults below the castle.

DAY 8 - NUREMBERG
