Later, rejoin your ship and cruise into the Wachau Valley to see its enchanting collection of castle ruins, terraced vineyards, and apricot orchards.

## DAY 5 – VIENNA

Welcome to Vienna, Austria's inimitable capital and City of Music, where anywhere you go, echoes remain of former monarchs and musicians. RIVERSIDE CHOICE offers a panoramic city tour and walk through the historical district, a visit to the Habsburgs' mighty Schönbrunn Palace, and other exciting possibilities.

### DAY 6 - MELK / GREIN

Today the fun begins in Melk! Early risers will appreciate the Wachau Valley's tranquil setting. After breakfast, arrive in Dürnstein with its ties to England's King Richard the Lionheart. RIVERSIDE CHOICE options include a hike up to the town's clifftop castle ruin; a visit to an Austrian vinotheque for a tasting of Wachau wines; and a guided visit along the Krems Art Mile for time at the State Gallery of Lower Austria.
