Ports include Esztergom, ancient Visegrád, Mohács with its colorful Busó culture, Kalocsa (Paprika Capital of the World), and an epic entrance into Budapest, where you can raise a glass of Tokaji aszú and toast the city's beauty.

DAY 1 – VIENNA

Welcome to Vienna, Austria's capital and wonderland of all things Habsburgs, music, and Baroque! DAY 2 – BRATISLAVA

DAY 4 - BUDAPEST

DAY 6 – KALOCSA

Another morning of scenic cruising gives you plenty of time for breakfast and to enjoy your ship's amenities. Later, disembark in Kalocsa, one of Hungary's oldest towns and the Paprika Capital of the World! An included guided excursion takes you to the 200-yearold Folk Art House. As you wander among the colorful rooms, see recreations of the homes where Serbian, Slovak, and Magyar peasants once lived, and meet skilled artisans who will teach you the fine art of painting everything from walls and furnishings to clothing in the traditional Hungarian way. Then, visit the Paprika House to learn about the history, traditions, and many cooking secrets for the rich and smoky "red gold". Finally, visit the Archbishop's Palace with its amazing library of 150,000 books and manuscripts, including the Vizsolyi Bible, the oldest surviving Hungarian Bible. After the tour, you're free to see more of this captivating town on your own. Back on the ship for your final onboard dinner

After breakfast, disembark the Riverside Mozart and enjoy complimentary transfers to the airport, train station, or central hotel.
