## DAY 3 – DÜSSELDORF

Arrive this morning in Düsseldorf, capital of the German state of North Rhine-Westphalia and a thriving international hub of business and finance. A wonderful menu of excursions will introduce you to its history, culture, and cuisine, and will explain why the dialect here is closely related to Dutch. Taste the food, sample the famous Altbier, and learn about the Düsseldorf Cartwheeler, Düsseldorf's oldest tradition and a symbol found throughout the cityscape.

## DAY 4 – RHINE GORGE SCENIC CRUISING / RÜDESHEIM

After a morning of scenic cruising through the castle-filled Rhine Gorge, you'll find there's a lot to see and do in the quaint wine village of

Rüdesheim. You could soar over the area by cable car and savor an authentic Rüdeshheimer Coffee; stroll through local vineyards and taste the area's exquisite wines; or pedal your way past Ehrenfels Castle and the 12th-century Abbey of St. Hildegarde during an e-bike tour. Tonight, after a delicious gourmet dinner on the ship, don't miss the RIVERSIDE SIGNATURE visit to the town's must-see collection of musical curiosities at Siegfried's Mechanical Music Museum. Afterward, enjoy an old-time silent movie experience – complete with champagne.

## DAY 5 – MANNHEIM / SPEYER

Mannheim is first on today's agenda! During a RIVERSIDE CHOICE guided walk, hear about the city's unusual street layout and ties to many inventions throughout history, then visit the massive Baroque palace (second in size only to Versailles). Other options are an outing to the ornamental Schwetzingen Palace Gardens, or a trip to Heidelberg. Reboard your ship for lunch and arrive later at 2,000-year-old Speyer, one of Germany's oldest cities. Here, a guided walk through the Old Town concludes with wine tasting. You could also join an enriching Jewish heritage tour; or visit the Technology Museum to peruse spectacular land, air, water, and space exhibits.

## DAY 6 – STRASBOURG

A big "bonjour" as you arrive in the unforgettable French city of Strasbourg, whose historic city center, the Grande Île (Grand Island), is a UNESCO World Heritage Site! Plenty of excursions show off the highlights, including a guided tour featuring the cathedral with its ancient astronomical clock. A cruise along the romantic canals is also available, as well as e-biking or an Alsatian wine tasting in the medieval village of Obernai.

## DAY 7 – BREISACH

In Breisach, you'll discover the captivating gateway between the French Alsace region and Germany's legendary Black Forest. Morning excursion choices are a guided city tour with a cellar wine tasting, or a hike through Ravenna Gorge. This afternoon, how about a guided e-bike tour, or a half-day visit to Freiburg, Germany's southernmost city?
