


SUNSET OVER THE DANUBE

Austria's relationship with the Danube is special – and the focus of this luxury cruise. Begin and end in Vienna with its Baroque architecture lining the Ringstrasse and rich coffee house culture that is often imitated but never duplicated. Other unforgettable ports include Dürnstein with its ties to King Richard the Lionheart; Melk, home to the impressive, ochre-colored abbey with its library of ancient manuscripts; Linz, birthplace of the world's first cake; Passau, the bustling City of Three Rivers; and Mauthausen, crossroads of two trade routes during Roman times. The Schlögen Loop and Wachau Valley top the trip with riverbank castles, terraced vineyards, and more!

DAY 1 – VIENNA

Welcome to Vienna, Austria's capital and wonderland of all things Habsburgs, music, and Baroque! Embark the Riverside Mozart and relax as you settle in. Tonight, toast your journey during your first gourmet dinner on board.

DAY 2 – VIENNA

Your entire day is dedicated to the exquisite City of Music. A RIVERSIDE CHOICE selection of excursions shows off the Habsburg rulers' stately Schönbrunn Palace or Prater Park by electric bicycle, with the chance to take a whirl on its famous giant Ferris wheel. Tonight, don't miss our RIVERSIDE SIGNATURE after-hours entrance into Belvedere Palace for a private orchestral performance and crowd-free viewing of Klimt's masterful "The Kiss".

DAY 3 – DÜRNSTEIN / WACHAU VALLEY SCENIC CRUISING / MELK

Compared to the grandiose architecture of Vienna, the quaint charm of Dürnstein is a stark contrast. With RIVERSIDE CHOICE, hike up to the town's clifftop castle ruin, where England's King Richard the Lionheart was imprisoned on his way home from the Crusades, or attend a tasting of the area's popular wines. If you're feeling ambitious, ride an e-bike along the river to your next port at Melk. Otherwise, reboard the ship for al fresco barbecue, prepared and served up on the Vista Deck as you pass through the stunning scenery of the Wachau Valley. The afternoon is in Melk, whose abbey is utterly amazing.

DAY 4 – MAUTHAUSEN / LINZ

Today can be as busy or relaxed as you like! RIVERSIDE CHOICE can whisk you off to "Sound of Music" Salzburg, the medieval walled village of Český Krumlov in the Czech Republic, or the Mauthausen Concentration Camp Memorial to learn about the area's tragic past during WWII. If you'd rather relax on board, this is a scenic day to do it. Arrive after lunch in Linz, a 2009 European Capital of Culture, where a tour through the Old Town shows off the massive, neo-Gothic Mariendom, or you can hike up Pöstlingberg hill overlooking Linz. Whatever you choose, it's sure to pair well with a big slice of Linzer Torte, the world's first cake.

DAY 5 – PASSAU

Port of call is in Passau, perched along the Route of Emperors and Kings. With RIVERSIDE CHOICE, consider a guided walk through the Old

Town to admire the work-of-art Town Hall, St. Stephen's Cathedral (home to one of the world's largest organs), and other highlights. Afterward, your efforts are rewarded with a frothy mug of refreshing Bavarian beer.

DAY 6 – GREIN

Enjoy a free and easy start to your day, then after lunch, step off the ship in tiny Grein. Among other excursion options, a RIVERSIDE SIGNATURE experience is available to 500-year-old Greinburg Castle, the oldest residential castle in Austria. After a warm welcome and champagne, embark on a guided tour to learn more about this ducal residence and hunting castle. See rooms decorated with priceless historical art and furnishings, the unique Sala Terrena (Stone Theater), Diamond Vault, Knights Hall, and more. Your visit is capped off with a riveting private concert – you'll truly feel like you've stepped back in time!

DAY 7 – WACHAU VALLEY / KREMS

An incredible final day as you cruise back through the UNESCO World Heritage Wachau Valley. The peaceful ambiance makes it easy to see why this stretch of the Danube has been inhabited since Neolithic times. To accent the experience, step up onto the Vista Deck, where a show-stopping al fresco barbecue is prepared and served among the scenic beauty. Afterward, stop in Krems to learn about apricots, one of the valley's most treasured crops. In fact, within the EU, the Wachau apricot is protected as its own brand. Visit the Bailoni distillery for a tasting of their famous apricot liqueurs, or join a Wachau Wine Experience with tasting.
